



What is housing advice?

Could you benefit from meeting with a housing advisor?

Housing advice provides support, assistance, guidance and counseling.

- It helps with various general housing-related situations
- including housing-related financial matters
- resolving housing-related debts and monitoring rent payments
- Housing advance also supports applying for housing, preventing homelessness
- resolving housing disturbances, neighbor disputes and neglect of apartment maintenance

It is recommended to contact housing advice services at a low threshold, so that more serious problems (such as homelessness, eviction, large debts, and so on) can be prevented. The service is free of charge.

Housing advice services operate by appointment and offer in-person consultations.

- At the Municipal Office (Alvar Aallon katu 9 C, Seinäjoki), reception hours are on Thursdays from 9:30–11:30 and 12:30–14:30.
- At the House of Services (Kasperinviita 13, Seinäjoki), reception hours are on the second Monday of each month from 11:00–13:00.
- At other times, services are available by appointment only.
